Project Highlights:

Interact with and make a difference in childrens lives!

- Assisting teachers to prepare for and execute lessons
- Conducting tutorials and giving extra assistance to pupils
- Assisting with marking and assessing children's progress
- Making teaching aids

More about our Antelope Park Teaching and Community Project:

Teaching is leading a child to responsible adulthood through imparting academic and life-skills. The children that you will come into contact with on this project are keen to be taught and moulded.

Through the academic support you will give them and their teachers, you have a chance to address the issues of oversubscribed classes and poor teacher-student ratios. With approximately 2184 students at Mkoba 4 Primary School, the average class size is 55 students with one teacher, with around 312 students per grade. Classes are hot seated as there are not enough classrooms and resources such as text books and teaching aids are also grossly inadequate. Here you have the chance to make teaching aids that can assist the teaching and learning process.

Although Somabula Primary School, with a total of about 280 children, is much smaller than Mkoba 4 they also need volunteers to assist. With student – teacher ratios being about 40:1, you can offer valuable support to the students who lack sufficient individual attention. The teachers also find themselves overwhelmed at times and welcome fresh ideas and enthusiasm. This school also has a significant number of boarders. These children are desperate for extra 'homely' attention assisting with their studies and social skills, but also caring for and making them feel special and important. Your presence on this project can make a meaningful difference to the lives of the children you come into contact with.

In working with the children, we also hope to reach out to impact the community through facilitating adult literacy classes. Volunteers with special skills can also use these to benefit the community.

Project Cost Includes:

- Funds that go back into the projects for items such as learning materials and building supplies to assist when possible
- All transfers to and from the project
- Depending on time of arrival and departure – overnight stay in Bulawayo or Harare, if required
- Full board and lodging which includes three meals a day

Project Orientation:

A day in the life of an Antelope Park Medical and Community volunteer... (Times vary depending on season)

6:45am	Breakfast at Antelope Park
7:30am	Arrive at school to assist as per duties allocated for the day
12:30pm	Lunch break where you have the chance to interact further with students or staff, or simply relax
2:00pm	Afternoon activities such as clubs, sports, remedial lesions, repairs, maintenance, gardening etc
4:00pm	Return to Antelope Park for the evening where you can relax, socialise, go for a swim, email, watch television, among the numerous activities Antelope Park has to offer

Throughout your placement you will have the support and guidance of our experienced volunteer coordinators. They are part of our support team, which will provide you with competent 24-hour field support and assistance.

During your stay at Antelope Park you will have the opportunity to enjoy an excursion to some of the other spectacular spots that Zimbabwe has to offer. Day trips are offered to the Great Zimbabwe Ruins as well as Granite Ridge and once a month a trip to the Victoria Falls is organised for those volunteers who are interested. These trips are also a great time for volunteers to interact and get to know each other better. The expedition such as the one outlined below (to Victoria Falls) will cost you approximately US\$475 (this includes National Parks fees, transport, meals – although not in Victoria Falls – and accommodation).

- Day 1: Leave after breakfast from Antelope Park for Miombo Safari Lodge (Hwange National Park); the largest national park in Zimbabwe, and the same size as Belgium! You will get the opportunity to go on a game drive in Big 5 territory where you could get up close and personal with a herd of elephant, buffalo, a pride of lion and many more.
- Day 2-4: Leave after breakfast from Miombo for Victoria Falls, adrenalin capital of Africa! You have the option to bungee jump, white water raft, visit the Falls, gorge swing across the Batoka Gorge below the Falls or just enjoy the great social atmosphere at this tourist hot-spot! Dinner at the amazing "Boma" Restaurant is included whilst at the Falls.
- Day 5: Depart early morning from Victoria Falls to return to Antelope Park

Note: This trip only operates with sufficient volunteer interest.

There is also the option of a day trip to Great Zimbabwe – the ancient founding city of modern day Zimbabwe. The cost of this trip is dependent on the number of people going. +/-USD60

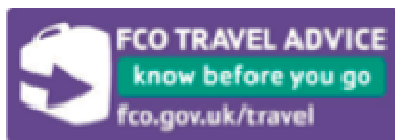
